Dear Prospective Clients:

Welcome to My Application Coach! Thank you for considering me as your application coach for Match#2026. Whether this is your first time applying for residency or you are reapplying, I am confident I can help you present a professional, polished application, although I cannot guarantee you will match.

Many of you have asked me how I work with my clients. Specifically, many prospective clients wish to understand the mechanics of a client session so that they can set their expectations. I trust that the brief comments below will with provide answers to the most commonly asked questions.

How do we work on my ERAS application?

• For the ERAS application, I ask my clients to use a specific editable form I have created, which they then submit to me. It's very easy to use and does not require completion in one setting. You simply save the form after each edit, and then return to wherever you have left off. During our session, I will provide suggestions and revisions I have made in advance. We will review my comments alongside your existing writing during our 90-minute session.

What about the Personal Statement?

• For the Personal Statement, I will review it thoroughly before our session, unless it is uploaded at the last minute. We will discuss it during our meeting, and I will offer general and specific suggestions. Whether you require additional time for feedback (via email or a shorter virtual session) will depend on several factors. A PS session is designed to review a single personal statement. If you are applying to multiple specialties and have written several different personal statements that vary considerably, I am happy to review these for you but such would require purchase of an additional session or sessions, which I offer at deeply discounted rates.

Will my ERAS Application or Personal Statement be finalized at the end of our session? What if some adjustments are still needed?

• I aim to finalize your ERAS Application and/or Personal Statement (PS) by the end of our session. However, if this goal is not met, we may still exchange a few emails between us for revisions until everything is complete. I do not charge for these additional revisions unless they become excessive. My goal is always to exceed my clients' expectations.

What about the Mock Interview? What should I expect?

• The Mock Interview session consists of one 90-minute meeting only. This session provides ample time to experience all the common questions asked during residency interviews, including behavioral questions. As is appropriate, I will tailor some of my interview questions to the specific specialty on which you wish me to focus. After the session, you will receive a link to review the video of your interview from start to finish. Typically, we spend about 45 minutes on the interview (much longer than a typical interview) and 45 minutes debriefing with a review of your specific answers.

I've decided to purchase your services. What happens next?

- Once you purchase my services, I will email you detailed instructions, including links to forms, videos, written guides, and additional information you may need. You can rest assured that you will have all the support you need to navigate the process effectively.
- All of my services are scheduled through myapplicationcoach.com. You will schedule each session at a time that is convenient for you.
- Please let me know if you are having difficulty navigating your purchase or if you have scheduling issues. It is common for foreign credit cards to be problematic, and your purchase may not go through. I suggest having an alternate source for payment, should that occur.
- All virtual meetings are conducted through ZOOM. Please ensure that you have installed ZOOM on
 your computer and that you have checked its functionality prior to our meeting. If there is an issue
 with an internet outage or a poor connection, I will reschedule your meeting free of charge. There is
 no way I could hold anyone accountable for such unexpected circumstances. While I have backup
 systems in place, the same is possible for me, and I expect the same consideration from you.
- Please join our session promptly at the scheduled time. I will generally wait 15 minutes before
 concluding that you are not joining and void the session. If extenuating circumstances preclude your
 availability, I will reschedule your session at my discretion. You can cancel and reschedule your
 session within 24 hours or more, should the need arise. If some urgency prevents you from joining
 our meeting, please contact me ASAP.

ERAS Application Review Session
